

STATE AGENCY SPENDS \$ 10 MILLION TAXPAYER DOLLARS TO SUPPRESS FARMWORKER VOTES



After abandoning farmworkers for almost 20 years and losing 90% of its members, the **United Farm Workers (UFW)** union returned to take 3% of workers' wages without giving them a choice.^{1,2}




Workers fought back and earned the right to an election, but the union objected.³



Now, the **Agricultural Labor Relations Board** (ALRB), the state agency created to give farmworkers a voice, which supervised the election in the first place, won't count their votes.¹

Paid one year of rent for more than 1,600 farmworkers. 10,11


INSTEAD, THE AGENCY SPENDS \$4,000 PER VOTE TO SUPPRESS FARMWORKER CHOICE

Statewide elections cost taxpayers about 55.30 PER VOTER




Destroying farmworker ballots costs taxpayers \$4,000 PER VOTER
